What you will need (for food vendors only)

- You will need 3 five gallon buckets marked wash, rinse, and sanitize for hand washing
- Disposable towels for hand drying
- Hair restraints such as hairnets and baseball caps are required at all times
- One gallon sanitation bucket and 5 towels to keep table tops and work areas clean
- Hot holding units for keeping hot foods hot
- Cold holding units for keeping cold foods cold
- All necessary utensils, plates and eating utensils
- Trash bags for garbage generated by your booth
- Fire extinguisher

What we will provide (for food vendors)

- 1 Table
- 2 Chairs
- Security
- Advertisement of the event
- Fire and food permit

What we will provide (for 15 non-food vendors)

- Fiesta Booth
- 1 Table
- 2 Chairs

A limited number of non-food vendors can pay \$100 to get a booth, table and two chairs. Other non-food vendors will pay \$50 and must provide their own table, booth/tent and chairs. **ALL FOOD VENDORS MUST ACCEPT TICKETS ONLY-NO EXCEPTIONS.**

All vendors may set-up on April 26th from 6:00am – 9:00am. Space is issued on a first come first served basis. Vendors participating in the St. Philip's College CultureFest are required to pay a \$75.00 refundable security deposit fee. Your security deposit and payment can be made online at the Alamo Colleges Marketplace Mall (https://secure.touchnet.com/C20015_ustores/web/index.jsp) or bring cash, check, or money order to the Turbon Student Center Room 110. Please pay before 03/23/18. The security deposit holds your vendor space. Full payment confirms your food item. Security deposits will be refunded at the end of the event. The security deposit is forfeited if a vendor fails to attend CultureFest, leaves before the end of the event, accepts anything other than tickets for payment, or does not completely clean their area. Food vendors will also be required to pay 10% of the revenue collected at the event. After the event ends, vendors will bring their tickets to cash out. All proceeds collected will benefit St. Philip's College students through scholarships.

Please note: Most of our food items are not duplicated. We do have items that are duplicated, meaning there will be more than one vendor selling them: funnel cakes, barbecue chicken, sausage, ribs, turkey legs, brisket, etc.

Refundable Deposit-If you pay the deposit by credit card, your deposit refund will go back to that card.

** The deposit holds your event space until **March 23, 2018**. This fee is forfeited if the vendor fails: 1) To pay the full vendor fee by **April 3, 2018 at 5:00pm**, 2) To remain until the 4pm closing time, or 3) To properly clean the vending area. The deposit is fully refundable at the end of the event.

We recommend that food vendors have a \$6.00 maximum on food items, so that we can make our event accessible to everyone. **ALL FOOD VENDORS MUST ACCEPT TICKETS ONLY-NO EXCEPTIONS. ALL food vendors will be required to take tickets instead of cash, credit or debit cards.** Tickets will be cashed out at the end of the event.
